You can pay for many government products and services online, the same way you pay your utility, cable or other bills and online merchants.

Most federal government agencies offer a variety of online payment options, including online bill payment through your bank's website making payments directly from your checking or savings account.

P **IT SAVES TIME:** You can make same-day payments, which means you don't have to allow time for mailing. Plus, you can also set up recurring payments.
